

GPABC Minutes April 14, 2010

Meeting called to order by Johnny Gardetto at 6:30 pm.

Opening Statement made by Johnny Gardetto. The GPABC Contact list was routed for attendance and corrections.

Grant Johnson noted that the Education Foundation is sponsoring an event on June 4th at Tuckaway. There will be a live band. Starts at 6:00 pm and there is a \$25 entrance fee.

March Minutes – Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved Minutes from the meeting on March 10, 2010. Minutes are posted on the website, www.greendaleboosterclub.org.

Johnny gave a special thanks to Steve Placek, Mark Brunelli and the Casino Night committee for a great event in February.

Project selection for Sprint sport (Gina Wilkins)

- The **wall mat panels** for the main gym were discussed. Due to the incident at SMHS, many parents are concerned about the safety in our gym. Gina spoke with Dr. Hughes and Mr. Lodes and there is an agreement to share the costs between the district and GPABC. The mat would cover the East gym wall door to door. Sixty foot wall mat with lettering, to include GPABC in corner.
 - --Motion was made and approved to have the GPABC provide \$1,500 of the cost for the mats.
- **Baseball:** The batting cage screen originally approved was taken off the table after discussions that concluded that the screening would not last very long. The district will be modifying the current batting cage for the new pitching machine. No date has been set for completion.
- **Softball:** Two catchers helmets were purchase for about \$150 (amount approved was \$400). Coach ordered six new batting helmets with the difference for \$252.88, plus shipping.
- **Baseball field:** Repairs to current infield estimated at \$8,500, The current field has numerous infield and outfield conditions that have become safety concerns. Discussion centered around the playing conditions for baseball, safety issues on the field and the area that youth football uses for practice. The overall goal for this repair is to fix the lip build up, home plate, pitchers mound and to regrade the field. There is a plan to totally revamp the baseball area but the group felt that this was too far out into the future to be realized and felt that this repair would go a long way to making the field safer now.
 - --Motion was made and approved to have the GPABC provide \$4,500 of the cost for this repair.
 - --Johnny Gardetto will discuss the concerns that were mentioned regarding youth football and their practice area.

AD Update –Gina Wilkins

Gina explained that when a team staffs a booth at Village Days, all proceeds must be shared among all team members, not just student athletes who work at the event. WIAA rules are very strict about this and this mainly affects the hockey team. Gina has been trying to find a way to have GPABC to get funds to our hockey players only but this has been very difficult. To date anything that has been mentioned would affect the amateur status of the players. A parent asked what the possibility would be for all the players on a co-op team (such as hockey) would all join our booster club and then they would be able to receive the funds. Thoughts were that would be unlikely that the other parents would support this suggestion. Gina will continue to work on this issue.

Homecoming will be September 24th.

Treasurer Report (see attached report) – Greg Turay reported that indoor concessions has now been added to the total for concessions. All Casino Night bills have been paid. Don't forget to use our Pick 'n

Save # when you shop. #296375. The booster club gets a percentage of your total bill. Upcoming events include the Flower Sales and the Golf Outing.
