

## GPABC Meeting Notes

June 9, 2010

**Meeting called to order** by Johnny Gardetto at 6:31 pm.

**Opening Statement** made by Johnny Gardetto. Johnny welcomed any new reps that were at this meeting, explained how the monthly meetings are done and reminded them that they would not be able to vote on any items until our July meeting. The new AD, Shane Hansen, was introduced and he spoke about his background. Gina Wilkins will be available until June 21. Attendance sheet and contact info sheet were passed around to insure information is accurate.

**Approval of May minutes** was made. Highlights included a Facilities update by Brian Koffarnus with support from Principal Steve Lodes and the four \$1,000 scholarships awarded to senior student athletes provided by the GPABC. The Booster Club also sincerely thanks out-going AD Gina Wilkins for her work with the GPABC and all GHS athletics. Gina has been a great liaison between the GPABC and the District and managed all athletic activities in very difficult economic times. We all wish her well in her new endeavors!!

**Project selection** was done by Gina Wilkins. Gina explained that the FY10 Project Selection summary review sheet that is attached was complete but for a few items that she was waiting for final invoices or items to arrive. She expected this to be done before her departure. This information will be on the booster club website when completed. The following Fall Sports Project Selection items were all approved (see attached itemized spreadsheet for details):

- Weight Room \$5,000 (Joint request from football/cross country/Girls/Boys basketball)
- Football \$1,366 (one opposed)
- Boys Soccer \$1,248
- Cheer \$1,460; \$3,500 uniform budget
- Cross Country \$858.53
- Girls Tennis \$1,280.40 (indoor court time not to exceed \$500)
- Girls Swim \$1,840
- Girls Volleyball \$3,696.20 (net system to be used by Girls/Boys teams)
- Boys Volleyball \$953.40
- Poms \$584.50 (garment bags are for storage)

(It was noted that for both Girls/Boys volleyball, 2 sets of Porter Athletic Competition Net Systems were requested but the board approved 1 set to be used by both Girls/Boys Volleyball Varsity teams & JV teams and that Girls Freshman team will use the current net system. Another net system will be taken under review for next year).

Total Fall Project Selection items = \$18,287.30

Uniforms = \$3,500

Total Fall Expenditures = \$21,787.03

**AD Update by Gina Wilkins.** The Fall sport parent meeting is July 21, 2010 at 6:30 pm at GHS. Check for information on mandatory physicals for fall sports athletes on the district website. The nurse practitioner for the district can do physicals. The form needed for physicals in on the school website under Athletics, student wellness.
